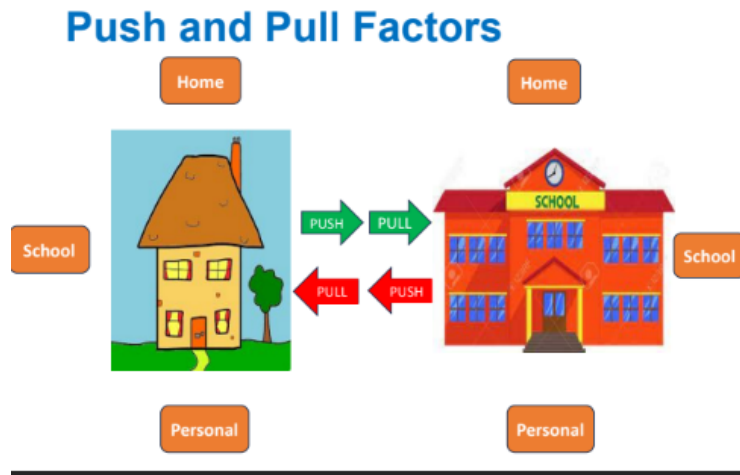


The staff at Wallsend Jubilee primary school work together to support your child to have good attendance. We will work with you as parents and carers to ensure that push and pull factors encourage your child to want to be in school and not to stay at home.

This is what you can expect to see at our school.



- Staff available and approachable every day on our school yard from 8:45am
- Staff will ensure that they quickly develop positive relationships with both yourselves and your children
- You will be kept informed, at least termly, of your child's attendance data. We will update you more often if necessary
- Our senior leaders will ensure that your child's teacher is aware of attendance data, at least half termly
- We will share your child's attendance data with you at parent's evenings, on interim and final year reports
- Mr Harrison will reward 100% attendance in school assemblies
- School assemblies will focus on the importance of good attendance
- Class teachers will promote the importance of good attendance with their class
- Our school office will share any updates from DFE or Gov regarding attendance and good health guidance
- After a period of non attendance our staff will support your child to return to school
- Our pupil premium lead will ensure that pupil premium funding promotes and encourages good attendance
- A good range of extra curricular activities both during and before/after the school day
- Visits, visitors and curriculum days to promote positive ethos of learning
- Breakfast club from Spring term 2024
- SEMH check in where necessary
- Bereavement support when required
- Opportunities for your child take on a role of responsibility, for example, a VIP or reading ambassador
- SEMH interventions, for example our invention shed
- Academic intervention, for example dyslexia support
- We will use Tapestry in EYFS and parentmail throughout school to keep you informed of upcoming events in school
- Transition days to reduce anxiety when moving in or moving on
